During this IPv6 Plugtests, your company can apply for IPv6 Ready Logo Phase I & II. On site, IPv6 Ready Logo Committee officer will examine, approve and grant the IPv6 Ready Logo. This is a gold opportunity for your company that you can not afford to miss.

China is the biggest potential IPv6 market and also IPv6 Plugtests is the first time to be held in China. In addition, Global IPv6 Summit is the most influential and prestigious IPv6 event in China.
